Expansion of Finlay Community School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and the School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013 that Gloucestershire County Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Finlay Community School, Finlay Road, Gloucester, Gloucestershire, GL4 6TR from 1st September 2019.

The proposal seeks approval to the expansion of the capacity at Finlay Community School from 210 pupils to 420 pupils by increasing the Published Admission Number from 30 to 60 for the reception intake in September 2019.

The current capacity of the school is 210 and the proposed capacity will be 420. The current number of pupils registered at the school is 268. The current admission number for the school is 30 and the proposed admission number will be 60.

Explanatory notes

1. The expansion is required to accommodate the rising primary school numbers in the Finlay area.
2. The school will be remodelled and extended to accommodate the additional pupils as they move through the school.
