What would you take?</p>	<p>Create a poster with your ten favourite Stone Age facts and present it to the class.</p>	<p>Imagine you are an archaeologist. Place small objects in sand, soil or rice and ask someone to find them using a small brush (like a toothbrush or makeup brush) or teaspoon. Ask someone to hide objects for you to find.</p>
